What sets the Mainstay Life Services' Summer Respite & Recreation Program apart from most traditional summer camps or programs is its ability to take advantage of the rich variety of recreational and cultural opportunities that Pittsburgh and the surrounding region offers.

Summer Program participants eat most of their meals at the college dining hall, and are able to use recreational facilities on campus, although most activities take place off campus.

Individuals attending the camp can participate in several activities each day including:

Camp Staff...

Mainstay Life Services' Summer Respite & Recreation Program is staffed 24-hours-a-day. Most staff members are professionals whose full time jobs are in the education and mental retardation fields. Some are college students who are planning to enter those professions.

Training for all staff is provided by Mainstay Life Services. Most camp staff are dedicated veterans who return to the camp summer after summer.

What is Mainstay Life Services' Summer Respite & Recreation Program?

- Since 1977, Mainstay Life Services' Summer Respite & Recreation Program has offered a unique socialization experience for adults with developmental disabilities.
- This program is held every July on a college campus in Pittsburgh.
- Participants choose from one or two week sessions and room in a college dormitory while they attend the camp.
- 40 individuals participate in the camp at any given time.
- Camp participation is open to adults (18 and over) who live with families or caregivers.
- The camp allows individuals to engage in recreational activities and social interactions that they might not otherwise have an opportunity to experience.
- Mainstay Life Services' Summer Program also serves as a respite program for families.
